Guidelines for Placement in Honors/AICE/AP Classes

Honors/AICE/AP classes require a commitment from the student **above and beyond** the work required for regular classes. This may include work to be completed during the summer vacation. It is important that you are aware of the expectations and requirements of the upper level courses before signing this request. **REQUIRED GUIDELINES:** Current **teacher recommendation** (in the same subject area). Minimum of **"B"** average earned in the current year's subject area. Fewer than **5 unexcused absences** in the current year. Student **MUST** remain in the requested class for the entire school year.

Foreign Language

Students are strongly encouraged to complete two consecutive years of the same world language or other equivalent prior to the start of 12th grade. Failure to complete the above may negatively impact eligibility for admission into a four-year university, Florida Bright Futures, other scholarships, and certain diploma designations.

Summer Florida Virtual School (FLVS)

One Florida Virtual Class (FLVS) is required for graduation. Students must register for summer FLVS through their student portal or www.flvs.net between **May 1st – May 15th**. Course completion date is **August 1st**.

It is important that you choose your classes wisely and complete this form carefully. Students will remain in the courses they have chosen for the entire school year. SCHEDULE CHANGES DUE TO A CHANGE OF MIND WILL NOT BE MADE AFTER MARCH 22, 2019. This subject selection is tentative until final School Board approval.
