
Graduation Requirements

- **Students must earn a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale**
- **Pass the FSA/ELA Grade 10 Reading and Algebra I EOC**
 - Reading Concordant Scores - ACT (19) or SAT (430 Verbal)
 - Algebra 1 EOC Concordant Scores - PERT (97).
- **Complete Community Service project**


Community Service

- A community service project is required for graduation
- Project may be completed through a service club or through individual effort
- Upon completion of the project, paperwork may be downloaded from www.mlecshs.com
- Beginning with the class of 2020, students must earn a minimum of 25 hours per year.
- Community service hours are due on
 - December 16, 2016 – 12th
 - February 3, 2017 – 11th
 - March 3, 2017 – 10th
 - April 21, 2017 – 9th (25 hours)
- Students who earn 250 community service hours will receive a community service cord to be worn at graduation

Honors/AP/AICE Courses

- All students are encouraged to take rigorous academic courses in their areas of strength
 - Students will earn college credits for taking and passing an AP course and the AP exam
 - Selected AICE (Cambridge) courses are open to students in other academies who meet eligibility requirements
 - All students should follow the 4 year plan.
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Guidelines for Placement in Honors/AP/AICE Courses

- Current teacher recommendation (in the same subject area).
 - Minimum of “B” average earned in the current year’s subject area.
 - Fewer than 5 unexcused absences in the current year.
 - Student must remain in the requested class for the entire school year.
 - AP elective courses need signature of future teacher listed on subject selection.
 - Honors/AP/ AICE US History courses need signature from current Language Arts teacher.

It is important that you choose your classes wisely and complete this form carefully. Students will remain in the courses they have chosen for the entire school year. **SCHEDULE CHANGES DUE TO A CHANGE OF MIND WILL NOT BE MADE AFTER MAY 20, 2017.** Parent conference is required for all schedule changes.
