

# AP Biology

## Summer Assignments

(a copy of this will be in Edmodo)

1. Sign into Edmodo using the group code: **tt24sa**
  - open for about 1-2 weeks to sign in
  - I will be populating it with folders later this month
    - Once populated
      - Review the folders on the various topics – there are some practice quizzes from various resource books
      - Download the Math Reference sheet and safety contract
      - View the Power Points on chapters 2-5 ( I realize you do not have a book yet)
  - If possible, obtain a resource book: ie. Barron's, Cliff, Prentice Hall, while they are in stock – just make sure it is a current edition. Review the section on Biochemistry – take notes and do the review questions.
  - Go to the AP College Board website “apcentral.collegboard.com” and review the course and exam descriptions, major topics/themes, and even sample tests. Know what is expected.
2. Go to Bozemanscience.com and under the video tab – AP Biology, view the following to get an overview on how the AP Bio has changed:

    - Complete the resource worksheets by Winnie Linton
3. Go to Bozemanscience.com and under the video tab on Biology (not AP Biology), view all videos in
  - Unit 2 – Chemistry of Life – Take notes during the video
    - Complete the resource worksheets by Winnie Linton located under the video
4. Search the web for access to AP Biology Campbell 9<sup>th</sup> ed. Read and take notes on Chapters 3-5
5. Additional items may be posted on Edmodo during the summer so check periodically
6. Due to school related activities that may take you out of class (excused or unexcused - student government, Clinicals, Sports, selling material for clubs, setting up for activities, etc.) you may want to think carefully about taking any AP class or multiple AP courses. The classes will not stop and you are responsible for making up assignments, tests, etc. on your own time.

\*Be ready for a **TEST** on the above material (Chemistry/Biochemistry) within the first two week - once schedule changes have been completed. This test will be on **YOU** to prepare for solely. The test will let you know the level of AP Biology and the detail you will need to know the material - so be prepared.
